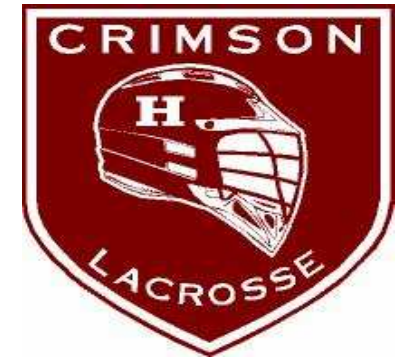

CAMP STAFF

The camp will be directed by the Harvard Lacrosse coaching staff: Head Coach John Tillman and Assistants Kevin Warne, J.L. Reppert and Charlie Congleton. Current players will also assist in providing personal instruction to each camper.

LOCATION/ FACILITIES

Harvard University, the world's most renowned educational institution, sits on the banks of the Charles River, minutes away from downtown Boston.

Campers will play on the Harvard University athletic complex practice fields and Harvard Stadium. All playing surfaces are field turf.

Boston University's West Campus dormitories will host the campers in a modern dorm and dining facilities. Campers will be transported via bus from the Boston University dorms to the Harvard University Athletics facilities.

EQUIPMENT

Campers will be required to provide their own equipment. Necessary equipment includes: Stick, Helmet, Gloves, Arm Pads, and Shoulder Pads.

Although our camp rents Harvard University's facilities, it is neither sponsored nor controlled by Harvard University. The camp complies with the regulations of the Massachusetts Dept. of Public Health (105CMR430.00) and is licensed by the Boston Board of Health.
